The Department of Chemistry, Diamond Harbour Women’s University, is one of the newest department of the University, having been formed in 2017. The first batch of this department started with 20 students in various parts of West Bengal. Initially 16 resource persons were engaged in teaching. At present it is being nourished by young permanent faculty members along with some guest faculties. The present intake of students is 30 in each year. The department has been offering three Advance papers in the final semester, viz. Inorganic Chemistry, Organic Chemistry and Physical Chemistry. The department also conducts special classes for NET/GATE etc. examinations. The students are engaged in different co-curricular activities to enhance their overall educational experience.

Starting from this year, the Department has grown exponentially; forming its Board of Studies and Board of Research Studies in 2019.
